

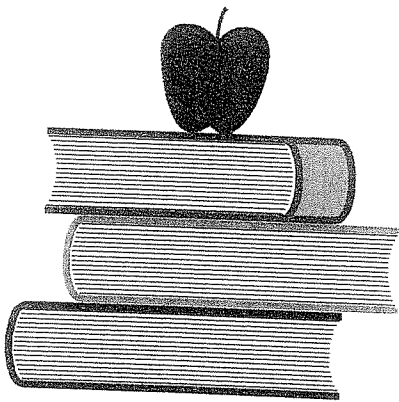

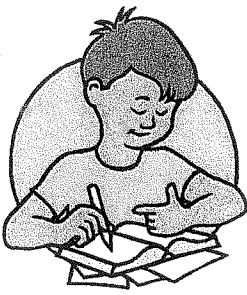
## Academics

Our belief is that all children can learn and succeed. We use a variety of instructional strategies to meet each child's needs, such as cooperative learning, small flexible groups and team teaching. Reading and writing are stressed across all curriculum areas. In math, the use of manipulatives helps our students understand the concepts behind the computation. Social Studies explorations and science experiments enable our students to problem solve and make connections. Good work habits and social skills are also emphasized throughout our school.

In addition to our core academic subjects, students take classes in art, music, physical education, library skills and technology.

## Character Education

We recognize that parents are the primary educators of character. Therefore, we have implemented an active Character Education initiative to support your efforts. 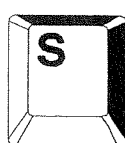
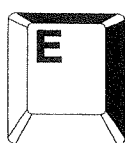
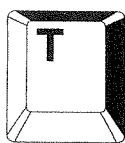

# Computer Technology Program

Tully Elementary has computers in every classroom, including the library! Our computer lab is equipped with Mac computers and is staffed by a full-time teaching assistant. Students use a variety of software programs as well as the Internet. Keyboarding skills are stressed in the intermediate grades. The computer lab staff and equipment are also used to support classroom teachers with their lessons.



## School-Home Connection

The school-home connection is important to us at TES. Parent volunteers are an integral part of our success. We have a very active and involved Parent Teacher Organization, which sponsors many activities that enrich our students' elementary experience. A monthly newsletter, "It's Elementary" is sent home to inform parents about school events.
