Dear Parents/Guardians,

Below is important information regarding bringing students back to full-time, in-person learning:

- Based upon our recent survey, most of our families want their children to return to fulltime, in-person learning. Also, about half of our families will need district provided transportation to and from school for their children.
- At this time, we anticipate that all program changes related to full-time, in-person learning will go into effect on Thursday, April 8, 2021. Our building principals will send out additional specific information to families as we get closer to that date.
- At this time, we anticipate that changes to bus routes will go into effect on Thursday, April 8, 2021. Families will receive additional specific information regarding changes to bus routes and to pick-up/drop-off times as we get closer to that date.
- In order to mitigate risks associated with having additional students in our school buildings, we will be implementing some additional public health measures. These measures include:
  - o Using barriers between students who are sitting closer than six feet.
  - Opening classroom windows whenever possible.
  - o Modifying expectations related to wearing masks. Here is a link to a poster which summarizes these expectations: Mask Up, Tully.
- All other public health measures utilized during the 2020-21 school year will remain in effect. These public health measures include ongoing cleaning, social distancing, hand washing and utilization of health screenings.

This represents another important step in our journey out of this pandemic.
