Below is important information regarding changes that will go into effect on **Thursday, April 8th**:

- All of our PreK-12 students will be enrolled either in a full-time in-person program, or a full-time remote learning program.
- Mr. Kupiec and Mrs. Murphy recently emailed specific information to families whose children will be making a change in their educational program. If your child is making a change in his/her educational program, and you have not yet received specific details from either Mr. Kupiec or Mrs. Murphy, please call either the Tully Elementary School Main Office (315-696-6213) or the Junior/Senior High School Main Office (315-696-6235)
- Mr. Bailey recently sent letters to the families whose children will be experiencing changes related to school transportation (i.e.: pick-up times, drop-off times). If you have any questions regarding changes to our bus routes, please call our Bus Garage (315-696-6250).
- Morning arrival procedures will change:
  - There will be no thru traffic on the school campus from 7:30-8:00am.
  - Upon morning arrival all school buses will park in the middle of the school campus, near the football field.
  - Parent drop-off will begin at 7:30am at the Elementary School Main Entrance.
  - Parent drop-off will begin at 7:30am at the Junior/Senior High School Main Entrance.
  - These are the same morning arrival procedures we followed during previous school years.
