Below is an update regarding recent revisions to our Tully CSD 2020-21 Reopening Plan:

- On Monday, June 7th the New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) issued a revised version of a document entitled *Interim Guidance for In-Person Instruction at Pre-K to Grade 12 Schools During the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency*. Revisions were made on pages 2, 4, and 9 of this document. These revisions allow for face masks to be optional for all people when outdoors on public school campuses. - Given this revised NYSDOH guidance document we will be revising pages 10 and 32 of our *Tully CSD 2020-21 Reopening Plan*. Specifically, our revised *Reopening Plan* will require face masks when in our school buildings or on our school buses.
