Dear Parents/Guardians/Faculty/Staff,

We were advised earlier today by the Onondaga County Health Department (November 12, 2020) that all of the students on one of our soccer teams will need to be quarantined. These students were exposed to an athlete from a neighboring school district who tested positive for COVID. This exposure occurred during a soccer game. A representative from the Onondaga County Health Department or from Tully Schools will reach out to the families of these students.

If you or anyone in your family is <u>not</u> contacted directly by either the Health Department or Tully Schools, this means that the health department has determined you were not exposed. Additionally, after discussing this situation with health department officials, we have determined that our schools will remain open at this time.

Quarantined students will not be allowed return to in-person instruction until their quarantine period is over. We hope you understand that we cannot provide any additional information about students who are quarantined due to confidentiality concerns.

Please continue to practice and encourage good hand-washing hygiene, wear face masks, and practice social distancing. If you or a family member start to exhibit symptoms of the virus (fever, shortness of breath, and coughing, for example), please reach out to your physician and inform the appropriate school nurse.
