Wellness Day: A Wellness Day will be held for our students on Friday, May 14th. A special schedule with shortened periods will be implemented. The wellness activities will begin around 1:30 pm and run through our regular dismissal. Students will be given a schedule closer to the date.

Remote students: Monday, May 10th is designated as the day for remote students to return to in-person learning if they wish. Please email Mrs. Murphy at mmurphy@tullyschools.org by Monday, May 3rd if you are interested in this option for your child(ren).

Last day of school: The last day of school for Junior Senior High School students is **Monday, June 21st**. The reason for going past the day listed on the school calendar is that by law, schools need to have a certain number of student contact days. Regents days count as student contact days to reach that number (see the paragraph below for more information about Regents exams). A final exam period will be held from Tuesday, June 15th through Monday, June 21st. A modified, 9 period schedule with a testing block in the morning that includes one day for each of the core subjects (English, Math, Science, Social Studies, and World Languages) will be implemented. Finals in other content areas will be administered during regular class times over the course of the week). The final exam schedule will be shared with students and parents as soon as it is complete.

Regents exams: New York State is administering Regents exams in the following courses: English, Living Environment, Algebra 1 and Earth Science. Students taking those exams will be given information by their teachers, including transportation to and from school. The Regents schedule is on the reverse of this newsletter. On Thursday, June 17th, all students enrolled in English 11 will sit for the Regents exam at 8:00 am and the remainder of our students will take their English finals during the morning testing block. Even though it is a Regents exam day, a full day of instruction will be held for all students. Regents testing on June 22nd, 23rd, and 24th will be considered student contact days. Only students scheduled to take tests on those days will need to report to school. Another letter for students who are in the classes that have Regents exams will be forthcoming in the near future.

Academic Achievement Night: Our annual Academic Achievement Night will be held on Thursday, June 3rd in a livestreaming format. Students receiving awards will receive an invitation in the mail to join the livestream event.
