Dear Parents/Guardians,

I am writing to provide you with an update on our current Capital Project. Below is information regarding work we anticipate completing over the next two weeks.

Regarding ongoing construction, over the next two weeks we anticipate that contractors will:

- Continue installing ductwork in the hallways in the Elementary School and in the areas near the JSHS Library. Please note that the heating system in the older part of the Elementary School will not be upgraded until the summer of 2019.
- Continue installing new doors at the Elementary School and the Junior Senior High School.
- Begin installing new locks on elementary classroom doors.
- Begin installing the new elementary school fire alarm system. Please note the current elementary school fire alarm system is currently functioning and will remain in place until we have finished installing and testing the new one.
- Complete renovations on the expanded bathrooms adjacent to the main gym at the JSHS.

Regarding recent third party inspections of our schools:

- Our board appointed OCM BOCES Safety Officer conducted the annual fire inspection of the Elementary School and the Junior Senior High School.
- Our board appointed OCM BOCES Safety Officer conducted air quality particulate testing in both the elementary school and the JSHS. The particulate counts in all areas tested were well below OSHA permissible exposure limits.
- Our Risk Management Representative from Utica National Insurance (the District's insurance carrier) conducted a risk management survey of our facilities.

The summary reports generated by these inspectors will be made available to the public, via the District website, after our District Safety Committee has had a chance to review them.
