Dear Tully School District Families,

On Wednesday, April 12th, a new traffic flow/pattern will be implemented for the morning arrival of faculty, staff, student drivers and students being dropped off. The new traffic flow/pattern is being implemented in an effort to create a safer, more orderly environment for people moving within the parking lot.

Currently, there are three lanes in the parking lot being used with no real set directional flow which causes potentially dangerous and unsafe conditions, especially in the morning hours.

The new traffic pattern/flow will consist of the following:

- The driving lane closest to the junior senior high school building will be an **Enter Only Lane** used for students driving to school*, students being dropped off at the athletic entrance and for faculty/staff arriving for the day.
- The center driving lane will be used by any vehicle dropping off students and will be designated as an **Exit Only Lane for the morning period.**
- The driving lane closest to the track side of the parking lot will also be an **Enter Only Lane** used by faculty/staff and student drivers arriving for the day.

*Note: student drivers must use the parking spaces closest to the track and at the south end of the parking lot.

To facilitate this change, there will be staff positioned throughout the parking lot to direct the flow of traffic. A map is on the reverse of this letter and posted on the school web site.

Additionally, please adhere to the 15 MPH speed limit on campus and be cognizant of pedestrians in the parking lot crossing traffic lanes, as well as entering and exiting vehicles. Pedestrians have the right of way especially when they are in the crosswalk.
