Dear Parents/Guardians,

I am writing to provide you with an update on our current Capital Project. Below is information regarding work we anticipate completing over the next two weeks, and information regarding inspections of the buildings that have occurred over the past two weeks.

Regarding ongoing construction, over the next two weeks we anticipate that contractors will:

- Continue to balance the new heating system at the Elementary School.
- Continue to install flashing and edging on the roof at the Elementary School.
- Continue to address punch list items in the new main office areas.
- Continue to install ductwork in the hallways in the Elementary School and in the areas near the JSHS Library.
- Continue installing permanent railings on the Elementary School exterior stairways.
- Begin to install new doors at the Elementary School and the Junior Senior High School.
- Begin to install permanent doors and glass in the ES office and the JSHS office.
- Begin tiling in the remodeled bathrooms near the JSHS lobby.

Regarding recent third party safety inspections of our schools, over the past two weeks:

- The Village of Tully Fire Marshal inspected the Elementary School. He found minor violations, all of which were corrected immediately.
- Our board appointed OCM BOCES Safety Officer conducted a wall-to-wall inspection of the Elementary School and the Junior Senior High School. He found minor violations, all of which were corrected immediately.

The summary reports generated by these two safety inspectors will be made available to the public, via the District website, after the Board of Education and our District Safety Committee have had a chance to review them.
