Dear Parents/Guardians,

I am writing to provide you with an update on our current Capital Project. Below is information regarding work we anticipate completing over the next two weeks, and information regarding inspections of the buildings that have occurred over the past two weeks.

Regarding ongoing construction, over the next two weeks we anticipate that contractors will:

- Continue installing insulation on the heating pipes in the Elementary School crawl spaces.
- Continue installing flashing and edging on the roof at the Elementary School.
- Continue to address punch list items in the new main office areas in the Elementary School and the Junior/Senior High School.
- Continue to install ductwork in the hallways in the Elementary School and in the areas near the JSHS Library.
- Begin to install permanent railings on the Elementary School exterior stairways.
- Begin to install new doors at the Elementary School and the Junior Senior High School.
- Install the new cafeteria tables at the Junior/Senior High School.
- Install new kitchen equipment in the Junior/Senior High School cafeteria serving area.

Regarding recent third party inspections of our school, over the past two weeks:

- Galson Labs conducted air quality testing in both the Elementary School and the Junior/Senior High School, which indicated that dust levels at both buildings is well below OSHA guidelines.
- The Onondaga County Health Department inspected the kitchens and cafeterias at the Elementary School and the Junior/Senior High School, and found no violations.
