Dear Parents/Guardians/Faculty/Staff:

Below is some information regarding changes to COVID-19 isolation and quarantine requirements:

- Going forward quarantine due to close contact to a COVID-19 positive person may be reduced to five (5) days. Here is a link to the Onondaga County Health Department guidance document with specific details related to this five (5) day quarantine period: [OCHD Guidance Document](#)
- Going forward in order to return to school at the end of a period of quarantine, the quarantined person must submit a *Self-Attestation: Affirmation of Quarantine* form. Parents/guardians must submit this form to the appropriate school nurse on behalf of their child. Faculty/staff must submit this form to the appropriate school administrator. - Going forward isolation due to a positive COVID-19 test result may be reduced to five (5) days. Here is a link to an Onondaga County Health Department guidance document with specific details related to this five (5) day isolation period: [OCHD Guidance Document](#)
- Going forward in order to return to school at the end of a period of isolation, the isolated person must submit a *Self-Attestation: Affirmation of Isolation* form. Parents/guardians must submit this form to the appropriate school nurse on behalf of their child. Faculty/staff must submit this form to the appropriate school administrator. - Going forward the definition of fully vaccinated has changed. Those eligible for a COVID-19 booster shot must now have received the booster shot in order to be considered fully vaccinated. - School personnel will be in contact with families tomorrow regarding adjustments to end dates for those students who are currently either in quarantine or in isolation.
