

By-Laws

SUBJECT: BUSINESS OF THE ANNUAL DISTRICT ELECTION

The Board of Education will appoint two (2) qualified voters as election inspectors of the Annual District Meeting and Election/Budget Vote. The election inspectors must have taken appropriate training through the Onondaga County Election Office for the use of the voting machines and paper ballots, as necessary. The chairperson is decided upon between the two (2) election inspectors. The chairperson will call the Annual District Meeting to order and proceed to the following order of business:

- a) Opening of the booths for voting at 6:00 a.m.;
- b) Closing of the booths at 9:00 p.m.;
- c) Announcement of the results of the elections;
- d) Signatures obtained from the two election inspectors, school business administrator and district clerk verifying the official results;
- e) Adjournment.
