



## **Tully Scholarships and Awards Description.**

**Applications for these awards are to be turned in to the counseling office by March 2nd. Applications received after this date will NOT be considered.**

### **For CURRENT JUNIORS:**

**Alfred University Scholar Award-** A student can be nominated if they have achieved an overall average of 3.0, taking a course of study that is college prep, and must complete their Alfred University application by December 1st, the selected recipient will receive \$18,000- \$30,000 per year.

**Alfred State College- Pioneers Leaders Award-** This is a pre-scholarship granted to high school juniors who demonstrate academic potential. Selected students will receive a scholarship as long as they enroll at Alfred State College for the fall semester immediately following their high school graduation. Students will be awarded \$1,000 to \$3,500 per year of study.

**Clarkson Leadership Scholarship-** Junior – Highest award from Clarkson: Recipient receive \$120,000, \$30,000/year over 4 years. Leadership skills, top 15% of the class, interest in engineering, business or science

**Clarkson Achievement Award-** \$120,000 or \$30,000/year over 4 years. Junior who has academic interest in engineering, business, or science

**Elmira College Key Award-** Liberal Arts and Science College- Awarded to one male and one female junior in the top 10% of the class for outstanding involvement in their community or school. Each award winner who visits the college in the fall of senior year and is accepted to the College receives a \$88,000 (\$22,000/year) Scholarship. Over 4 years

**Keuka College George H. Ball Community Achievement Award** - \$6,000 to 12,000/yr for up to 4 yrs. scholarship for up to 5 juniors who demonstrate a strong academic record and who exhibit leadership ability through school and community activities. Award recipients may also be eligible for other scholarships once they apply and receive admission to Keuka College.

**Le Moyne College Heights Award-** Junior in top 10% of their class, 90 average, scored a 500 minimum on PSAT each section. These students show leadership skills in school or in the community. \$17,000/year scholarship- Le Moyne allows us to pick two students.

### **Rensselaer Medal Award**

The Rensselaer Medal is a scholarship opportunity worth \$160,000 for outstanding math and science students. The Rensselaer Medal is awarded to promising secondary school students who have distinguished themselves in mathematics and science, with a 95 overall average in a rigorous college preparatory program.

**Rochester Institute of Technology Awards.:** Each approved nominee will have their application fee waived and receive an undergraduate scholarship valued at \$96,000 (\$24,000 per year), if

they are accepted for admission to an RIT BS/BFA program. For each scholarship, the nominee must be a junior with a 94 or higher GPA and in a rigorous college-preparatory program.

#### **RIT Computing Award**

- Students should be active and involved members of their school and/or community:
- Superior grades in computing-related classes
- Completion of a school or community project that demonstrates high-level knowledge or experience in computing, or High-level use of computing in other areas such as business, science, math, art, design, film, animation, or photography.

#### **RIT Science and Math Award**

- Superior grades in science and/or math-related classes
- Interest in pursuing college-level course work in science and/or math, or interest in using science and/or math in other areas such as business, engineering, health sciences, technology, or computing.

#### **RIT Art and Design Award**

- Superior grades in art and design-related classes
- Use of creative and innovative thinking in areas such as art, crafts, design, film, animation, or photography
- Extensive art portfolio or recipient of art awards

#### **RIT Business and Leadership Award**

- Superior grades in business and leadership-related classes
- Completion of a school or community project that demonstrates a high level of developing innovative solutions to problems such as starting their own business, community service, or extensive involvement in leadership activities.

#### **RIT Humanities and Social Science Award**

- Superior grades in humanities and social sciences-related classes, such as economics, psychology, history, foreign language, and global education.
- Completion of a school or community project that demonstrates commitment and understanding of our political, cultural, economic, and social world.

#### **RIT Women in STEM Award**

- Superior grades in science, computing, and math-related classes
- Interest in pursuing college-level course work in areas such as science, math, computing, engineering, technology, and health sciences

**Sage Colleges Award-** 5 student leaders in the junior class who are role models with community service and solid academic performance, scholarship is at least \$14,000-\$20,000/year for 4 years for winners depending on academic performance.

**St. Bonaventure Bonnie Scholarship-** Given to students with an 85+ average in core courses, and demonstrate an interest in acquiring a great depth of knowledge at a liberal arts institution and will embrace the mission and values of St. Bonaventure. Student are eligible to receive a \$22,000/year for four years depending on academic performance review.

**St. Lawrence University Book Award-** Junior who shows citizenship and leadership. Submit an essay for scholarship competition- 4 year liberal arts college in Canton. Book is *Mountains Beyond Mountains* by Tracy Kidder (Pulitzer Prize Winning author) and a \$4,000 scholarship at \$1,000/year. Winner is highly encouraged to apply for their Community Service Scholarship.

**St. Michael's College, Vermont- Book Award for Scholarship and Service**

Given to 2 juniors who have high achievement in academics and sincere commitment to community service, issues of peace and justice. St. Michael's College is a 4-yr Liberal Arts College in Northern Vermont-Burlington. The award recipient may also be considered for a scholarship ranging from \$16,000 to full tuition with acceptance to the college.

**University of Rochester Humanities/Social Sciences Award-** Junior who has shown outstanding achievement in Social Sciences, demonstrated commitment to understanding and addressing difficult social issues, is a leader, and is dedicated to community action. Winners will have their application fee waived and will be considered for the Fredrick Douglas/Susan Anthony scholarship program at U of R and could receive at least \$5,000/year, based on academic performance.

**University of Rochester-Xerox Award for Innovation and Information Technology-** Award for outstanding junior with a strong interest in innovation and/or information technology and a high level of achievement in this area. Winner will have their application fee waived and will be considered for Xerox scholarship of \$5,000/year.

**University of Rochester George Eastman Young Leaders Award-**Award for outstanding junior with extensive involvement in extracurricular activities and with high academic performance. Winners will have their application fee waived and will be considered for the Kodak Scholarship worth \$5,000/year.

**University of Rochester Bausch & Lomb Honorary Science Award-** Award for outstanding junior with outstanding achievement and rigor in science and math classes, and have made positive contributions to their school and within the larger community. Recipient will have their application fee waived and will be awarded a scholarship valued \$5,000 per year.
