Dear Parent, Guardian, and School Staff

New York State Education Law Section 409 H effective July 1, 2001, requires all public and non-public elementary and secondary schools to provide written notification to all persons in parental relation, faculty and staff regarding the potential use of pesticides throughout the school year.

The Tully Central School District is required to maintain the list of persons in parental relation, faculty and staff who wish to receive a 48-hour written notification of certain pesticide applications. The following pesticide applications are not subject to prior notification requirements:

- The school grounds remain unoccupied for a continuous 72 hours following an application wardrobe.
- Anti-microbial products.
- Nonvolatile rodenticides in tamper resistant bait stations in areas inaccessible to children.
- Nonvolatile insecticidal baits in tamper resistant bait stations in areas inaccessible to children.
- Silica gels and other ready to use pastes, foams or gels in areas inaccessible to children.
- Boric acid and disodium octa borate tetrahydrate.
- The application of EPA designated biopesticides.
- The application of EPA designated exempt materials under 40CFR 152.25.
- The use of aerosol products with a directed spray in containers of 18 fluid ounces or less when used to protect individuals from imminent threat from stinging and biting insects including venomous spiders, bees, wasps, and hornets.

In the event of an emergency application necessary to protect against an imminent threat to human health, a good faith effort will be made to supply written notification to those on the 48-hour prior notification list.
