



The Tully Central School District encompasses 80 square miles in southern Onondaga County. The campus is located in the center of the village of Tully. The current K-12 enrollment of 729 students is served by a staff of approximately 83 teachers and 24 teaching assistants across two academic buildings on one campus.

 - Tully Jr./Sr. High School - 337 (7-12)

- The 2022-2023 budget of \$22,548,248 supports many outstanding programs. State Aid provides 49% of the budget with approximately 48% from local taxes. The balance of the budget, approximately 3%, comes from other sources including appropriations from fund balance, sales tax and interest earned.

- The District's administrative team consists of: Superintendent of Schools, School Business Administrator, K-6 Principal, Director of Student Support Services, 7-12 Principal, Director of Instructional Support Services, Information Technology Manager, Athletic Director, Superintendent of Buildings and Grounds, Transportation Supervisor and School Lunch Manager.

OUR DISTRICT

The Tully Central School District is conveniently located just 15 minutes outside of Syracuse, N.Y., right off of Route 81. The school campus is centrally located within the district. Within a short drive are several excellent hospitals, health-care facilities and institutions of higher education, including Syracuse University, SUNY College of Environmental Science and Forestry, Le Moyne College, Onondaga Community College, SUNY Cortland and Tompkins Cortland Community College. Also in close proximity is the Everson Museum of Art, the Milton J. Rubenstein Museum of Science and Technology, the Rosamond Gifford Zoo and the Destiny USA shopping mall.

Living in the district offers the opportunity for many recreational activities. There are four ski resorts within 20 minutes of the village. Several golf courses are nearby, as are county parks and public lakes, that provide areas for camping, hiking, biking, kayaking and boating.

OUR SCHOOLS

The Tully Central School District prides itself on being one of the last remaining community school districts in New York State and the focal point of the Tully area. The district has many unique attributes and accomplishments that sets it apart from other districts in the area. Highlights of these attributes include:

- Extensive participation in extra and co-curricular activities – 86% of our students participate in some type of activity such as drama club, sports teams, student council, band, chorus, or Campus Wide Dialogue, a collaboration with Syracuse City Schools.
- Significant participation in a number of Onondaga Community College and Tompkins Cortland Community College credit-bearing classes, as well as Career & Technical Education programs.
- A comprehensive preschool program, an inclusive full continuum Special Education program, Maker Lab and several intramurals available.
- Unique community programs such as the Youth Advisory Committee at Tully Free Library and the Tully After School Program (TASP) housed at the elementary school.
- A rich tradition in athletics. The Black Knights are highly respected in a variety of sports. On top of annual league championships, sectional championships, and several state championships achieved over the years, our varsity teams, comprised of over 50% of the student body, qualify as scholar athlete teams each season. In addition, Tully has a tremendously gifted coaching staff and a very supportive community.
