

Voting – August 2, 2022 – 7:00am – 9:00pm – elementary school gymnasium

Designated voter parking in the elementary school parking lot. Signs directing you to parking spots. Please do not park in Tully Free Library designated parking spots (directly behind the library).

Signs directing you to the door (near handicapped ramp).

One of the two certified voting election inspectors, may ask you for proof of residency. It is a good idea to have your driver's license with you, or another form of proof of residency that lists your physical address. PO Box is not proof of residency.

In order to vote you must be:

A United States citizen

At least 18 years of age

A resident of the school district for at least 30 days preceding the vote

Timeline for those interested in obtaining BOE Candidate and for those interested in voting by absentee ballot (if you are unable to personally appear on the day of the special election):

- Tuesday, June 14 - BOE Candidate Petitions available - District Office
- Tuesday, June 14 - Applications for Absentee Ballot available (if you are unable to personally appear on the day of the special election) - District Office
- Friday, July 1 - BOE Candidate Petitions **due into District Office** - 5:00pm
- Tuesday, July 5 - BOE Candidate Ballot **Position Drawing** - District Office 10:00am
- Friday, July 8 - Absentee Ballot available
- Tuesday, July 26 - Application for Absentee Ballot (mailed version) requested 7 days before the vote
- Monday, August 1 - Application for Absentee Ballot (picked up in person) - returned in person up to day before the vote
- Tuesday, August 2 - Special Election - 7:00am - 9:00 pm "mailed" absentee ballots received not later than 5:00pm on the day of election
