

Voting - May 17, 2022 - 6:00am - 9:00pm - **elementary school gymnasium**

Designated voter parking in the elementary school parking lot. Signs directing you to parking spots. Please do not park in Tully Free Library designated parking spots (directly behind the library).

Signs directing you to the door (near handicapped ramp).

One of the two certified voting election inspectors, may ask you for proof of residency. It is a good idea to have your driver's license with you, or another form of proof of residency that lists your physical address. PO Box is not proof of residency.

In order to vote you must be:

A United States citizen

At least 18 years of age

A resident of the school district for at least 30 days preceding the vote

In the event you are personally unable to appear on election day between the hours of 6:00am-9:00pm, you may request an **application for absentee ballot** from the district clerk.

Completed **application for absentee ballot** must be received by the district clerk at least 7 days preceding the May 17, 2022 meeting of voters if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or at least the day before such meeting of voters if the ballot is to be delivered to the voter. An absentee ballot, instructions and return envelope will then be provided to the voter.

An **absentee ballot** must reach the office of the District Clerk or Board designee not later than 5:00pm on the day of the election/vote in order that his/her vote may be canvassed.

A listing of all persons to whom an **absentee ballot** is issued will be available for inspection by any qualified voter in the Office of the Clerk during its regular hours (7:30am - 4:00pm) on each of the five days prior to the day of such meeting of voters, except Saturday, Sunday or holiday.
